

Wallaby Tracks Adventure Tours

¾ Day 4WD Tour “Wilpena Pound & Gorges”



Highlights:

Departing at 8.00am from Quorn - We spend 6 hours showcasing the Ikara-Flinders Ranges National Park which offers an abundance of wildlife including the Yellow Footed Rock Wallaby, as well as Red kangaroos, Western Grey kangaroos, Euros or Wallaroos and also some spectacular bird life.

We travel along the Moralana Scenic Drive and enjoy the morning light against the Elder Range.

We look at the amazing ancient geological rock formations of the Brachina and Bunyerroo Gorges, and including a viewing of an ancient marine fossil - the Archaeocyatha Fossil - 530 million years old.

The scenery is stunning and diverse – from deep inside the gorges to the open expansive views from the Razorbacks Lookout.

During spring there are wild flowers in bloom and there is always a high possibility of seeing emu's and wedge tailed eagles in their natural environment.
